

ERRORS ON VIDEO - ANSWERS

1 – DECISIVE ERROR SS

Decisive error – muffed catch. Batter reached on a fielder's choice, while the runner from second to third reached on a 5-E6. Good throw from third baseman was muffed by the shortstop, third baseman still gets credited with an assist. Capitalise the error to show the runner should have been out at third.

2 - EXTRA BASE ERROR CF

Record an attempted pick-off wt1 (lower case) for the runner's movement to third, and then a fielding error by the centre fielder (e8) that allowed the runner to come home. Two separate errors, with a line linking the two bases to show that they occurred in the same play.

3 - DECISIVE ERROR LF

Decisive error. The batter-runner would have been out if the left-fielder had taken the catch (and the catch only required ordinary effort). (MF7)

4 - MUFFED FLY ERROR SS

Example of a dropped catch, where another player interfered with the catch. In this instance, error the shortstop.

5 - MUFFED FLY NO ERROR

Example of a muffed fly where the fielder doesn't receive an error, because a forced out made at second. Record it as FC9 on the batter, 9-6 on the runner.

6 - DECISIVE ERROR SS

The batter-runner would have been out if the short stop had thrown an accurate throw. (WT6)
